
A Pronoun Circle is something that you do during introductions at an event or in a group.

While going around the room to say your name you also state your pronouns - She/Her, He/Him, They/Them etc.

Below is an example of how one might look:



Holding a Pronoun Circle when you do introductions supports Trans and Non-Binary people by allowing people to state how they should be referred to and not how *other* people decide they should be referred to, it also helps to normalise that some people don't use She/Her or He/Him pronouns and don't wish to be referred to as a woman or a man.

This helps lower the risk of misgendering.
