- 1. Our shared online spaces are safer spaces to learn and to ask for advice and support, as well as to socialise.
- Listen to and respect others opinions and their lived experiences. Listen to others
 when they state something is problematic. Their lived experience may be
 different to yours. The non-binary community is a diverse community and we can
 all learn from each other.
- 3. If you make a mistake, apologise and move on.
- 4. If you would like to post links or non-related images, then check with an admin of that space. All our shared online spaces are moderated by admins.
- 5. Do not share events, links, images or information from these shared online spaces outside of them. If you wish to share information then consult the admins on the best way to do this.
- 6. Do not add or invite people to our shared online spaces that are private. This is something only admins should do. If there is someone you would like to add or invite then talk to the admins.
- Do not add people from shared online spaces as friends on Facebook and other social media or message them outside of these spaces without them consenting to this first.
- 8. Any issues should be raised with an admin or committee member and it will be dealt with as soon as possible
- 9. Use Content Notes/Trigger Warnings where necessary
